

Peninsula Booth Configuration

SPECIAL NOTICE:


Peninsula (end-cap) booths are comprised of two corner booths that face three aisles.

To maintain sight lines, the width of the back wall of all peninsula booths must be limited to one-half of the overall width of the space, centered. Maximum height of the centered back wall is eight feet (8'), and the remaining back wall height cannot exceed three feet (3'). In addition, display materials may not block sight lines to adjacent booths. See illustration.

A booth design complying with these setup regulations must be submitted to Exhibit Management for approval prior to move-in onsite.
